Summit: the Ultimate Journey Destination

[Summit](#) is a national gathering of Journey students for four days of competition, celebration and fellowship each April in rotating locations across the country.



Students are quick to cite the benefits of attending Summit, including increased unity within their youth group, growth in their relationship with God, the opportunity to meet and compete with students from around the U.S. and the simple pleasure of good, clean, all-out fun.

Summit features a Christian college fair, the Citation Award ceremony and opening and closing ceremonies, but the biggest draw is the competition. Students compete in AwanaGames™, Bible Quizzing, Fine Arts and volleyball and basketball tournaments. College scholarships are given for winners in Bible Quizzing and some Fine Arts categories.

The Fine Arts competition is designed to help encourage students to develop their ministry-related gifts. The two basic categories are musical and non-musical. The musical categories are piano, vocal (solo and group) and instrumental. The non-musical categories include public speaking, writing and graphic design.

Grand Prix

The Awana Grand Prix is a family-oriented affair that allows clubbers to express their ingenuity by creating and racing their own wooden Grand Prix cars while enabling clubs to share God's plan of salvation with clubbers' unsaved family members by attracting them to a fun event involving their child. Many clubs include a special race for parents and leaders caught up in the excitement of crafting their own cars. Grand Prix events usually last about two hours or the equivalent of one club meeting.

Weeks before the race, clubbers purchase small pine blocks of wood and plastic wheels from which they construct their cars (see the Ministry Catalog or Ministry Guide online to purchase materials), usually with the help of a parent or leader. Many churches also offer a "Grand Prix Construction Workshop" to help beginners and those not mechanically gifted.

The cars race on a four-lane track. Awards are given for both design and speed. Clubs award first-, second- and third-place trophies for each category. Each clubber who participates also receives a ribbon.

The Grand Prix provides a challenging, stimulating change in the club year that can draw children back after holidays or a drop in attendance. Children's parents also get involved and the gospel is presented after check-in but prior to races so unsaved family members hear God's plan of salvation clearly presented. The Awana Grand Prix is not only a fun activity but a powerful tool for reaching unsaved family members.

“What is this?” you might be saying. This past summer we tried to put together a special event for the 2006-07 Oklahoma Citation Achievers, however, because it was short notice, most had already made unchangeable plans. The Ministry Calendar became quickly filled, and we had to cancel.

No excuses this year! The date is already on our calendar. If you have Citation Achievers please put this date on your calendar, and announce it to your kids. Saturday, June 14, 2008 in Oklahoma City. The exact location will be announced closer to the date. We will be supplying the food. Kids should bring whatever they would like to drink. This will be an indoor / outdoor event, so dress is casual. This will include Citation Achievers from both 2006-07 and 2007-08.

Dress Code: Because we will be in church auditoriums, we do have a dress code for Bible Quiz events: Awana uniform with slacks / khakis (or at least knee-length skirts for girls. *Ladies, if your girls are wearing skirts, please teach them to sit like a lady as they will be facing the audience. Thanks!*) If your church does not use uniforms, dress shirts will be acceptable. Example of Unacceptable dress: Non-uniform T-shirts and flip-flops. Note: We understand that some families are just not able to afford “dress clothes,” and we do not want this to be a barrier that would keep kids from participating. However, we also want to teach respect for the worship center. Therefore if your clubbers are able to wear slacks / khakis rather than jeans, please have them to do so. If jeans are worn, please ensure that they are nice jeans – black if possible; limit the number of holes and fraying, etc. As former coaches, we personally used to keep a couple of loaner pairs of clothing for just this type of occasion. You can usually find good items at Goodwill or Salvation Army for little to nothing.

Training is being held at Conference this year. If it is determined that we need to have another meeting closer to the time of Quiz, we will announce it at that time.

In addition to having a coach for each team, each church is required to supply a scorekeeper (this should be someone who is good at math) and one additional worker. Both of these people should be volunteers who are able to stay for the entire event. Jobs that the additional worker may be responsible for: Check-in, Judge, Timer, carrying the microphone to the recognized teams during the speed round, Set-up, Clean-Up, etc.

AwanaGames / Sparks-a-Rama General Information

Coaches Training is ONLY being held at Conference this year. We will have an Officials training meeting sometime in January. The exact date and location are to be announced closer to time.

Rulebooks are available at Coaches Training at Conference, and they will be placed online sometime in November/December.

Additional Requirements:

Dress Code: Team T-shirts or uniforms. Participants **MUST** wear **CLEAN GYM SHOES**. Please do not have your kids wear the shoes they will participate in to the event. Some of the gym floors we will be using are new or have been recently resurfaced. We do not want to take the chance of rocks, etc. getting wedged into shoes soles and scratching these floors. Note: **GYM SHOES ONLY** (no crocs or flip-flops) for safety purposes. **NO SHORTS**. Participants and Coaches must wear gym pants, fitted jeans (not too tight or too loose), or wind pants (no break-aways). **NO SKIRTS**. If churches require girls to wear culottes, they must be at least tee-length.

Permission Slips and Medical / Photo Waivers: Each child is required to have a current permission slip on file before being allowed on the gamefloor. We also need (can be included on the permission slip or on a different form): A) a medical waiver that allows emergency treatment, B) a list of any medical conditions, medications or allergies, and C) permission 1) to video / photograph children and 2) feature said videos / photographs on church and / or organizational website(s) for newsletters / future event promotional purposes. These forms must stay on file for a period of at least one year following the event, and if we decide to use videos / photos on our website, we will contact you to obtain copies of these waivers.
